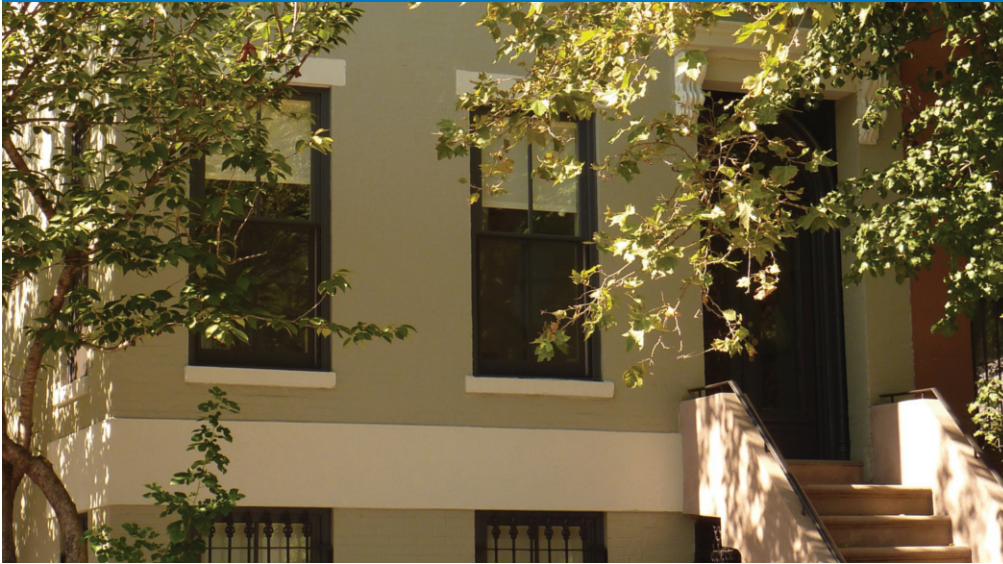


New York City Residential High-Efficiency Natural Gas Heating Program
